

# WTRA Net Script

Calling all Amateurs...Calling all amateurs...It is now 7:30PM and time for the Western Tidewater Radio Association repeater and RACES District Ten Net.

Net control for this session is **URCALL**, located in **URQTH**, and my name is **URNAME**.

This net meets each Thursday at 7:30PM. The purpose of the net is to handle traffic into and out of the Smithfield and Isle of Wight area. The net also handles announcements, comments or questions about this repeater, RACES District Ten, and WTRA club activities, and WTRA-VE test scheduling. Club activities, Amateur Radio test registration and other information are available on the club's website at [www.wt4ra.org](http://www.wt4ra.org). This net and our activities are intended for the promotion of the Amateur Radio service.

<Start traffic portion >

At this time is there any formal traffic?

*(Note: No need to ask for emergency, priority and routine traffic separately. If there is traffic, ask stations listening if any will take the traffic, grant direct and let the stations pass the traffic.)*

<Announcements and Bulletins>

Are there announcements or Bulletins for the Net?

*(Note: Net Control starts by announcing one or two upcoming club activities to get things going. It is the Net Control Station's option to allow each station with announcements to make them as they come on frequency, or to have all the stations with announcements call and then rotate through them.)*

This is **URCALL** with the WTRA net in progress. Please check in with your Call Sign, name and location. Stations monitoring the net are requested to announce your status by checking in and out. All stations checking in will be given an opportunity to address the net with their comments.

Limited time or mobile stations please call now.

*(Note: Take battery power and mobile stations first and let them make comments. Batteries die and mobile stations can move out of repeater range.)*

All stations wishing to check in call net control now.

*(Note: Here the Net Control Station may use any procedure necessary to maintain order on the net. You may allow check-in alphabetically, geographically, number of years licensed; and it is okay to have a little fun with it.)*

[Now the Net Control Station goes back for comments and it is okay to go around the list more than once. Call for additional check-ins and take their comments.]

<Close the net>

This is **URCALL**, Net control station for the Western Tidewater Radio Association and District Ten Net. We had # stations check in and # traffic for this session. Thanks for your participation. Please stand by for repeater reset. (PTT + 6380) (repeater also resets automatically at 8:00 PM).
